The Oshkosh Area Community Foundation Hiwela Grant Committee and the Board of Governors have approved a \$2,000 grant to the Boys' & Girls' Brigade in Neenah. The Hiwela Youth Fund grant will help fund financial scholarship assistance to 6th-12th grade youth attending summer camp at Camp Onaway in 2011.

The Brigade's week-long camps at Camp Onaway include three boys' camps, three girls' camps, Onaway Adventure Camp and Leadership Training Conference held June through August on Onaway Island on the Chain O' Lakes in Waupaca. The camps are staffed by experienced adult volunteer mentors with a low camper to leader ratio providing a fun family atmosphere. The unique island environment offers lots of opportunity for water and other activities that help youth reconnect with nature and build lifelong friendships.

The Brigade includes round trip bus transportation to all of the camps departing from and returning to Neenah. Registration is open to all youth in 6th-12th grades and not just Brigade members.
