A Message From The Executive Director

After the downtown program cycle ended, we surveyed* participants as part of continuous improvement efforts, highlights appear below:

-92% looked forward to returning next year

-89% felt cared for by their leaders and saw them as role models

-90% believe their Brigade involvement helps them abstain from risky behaviors such as alcohol, drug and tobacco use

-90% indicated that their Brigade involvement has taught them to be a better person *we had a 44% response rate (210 of 480 registered)

As always, we are grateful for the many volunteers who are essential to the downtown program, and hope the experience is rewarding for you as well. Please feel free to give us feedback on the menu of opportunities, communication, building condition, staff support or anything else that impacts volunteer satisfaction.
