



### remebering dick jelinski

It is with heavy hearts that we share the news of the passing of a beloved and dedicated Brigade volunteer, Richard "Dick" Jelinski. He was a library of wisdom and a benchmark of character within The Brigade. His legacy will be etched in the hearts of those who had the privilege of knowing him.

Dick's life was a tapestry of remarkable achievements, and he lived each day to its fullest. From his service in the US Navy during the Korean War to his diverse passions in photography, painting, scuba diving, sculpture, and more, he exemplified the essence of a life well-lived. His most enduring legacy is his unwavering dedication to The Brigade, where he served as a leader for an astounding **71 years**. Dick was the first recipient of the Outstanding Brigader Award in 1950, 6 year medal recipient, a beloved leader at Boys' Camp 2, an active leader at the downtown program, and an active work week volunteer. In 2016, he received the S.F. Shattuck Award. He was a Board Member and honored Emeriti on the Board. Dick's impact on The Brigade and those that connected with him is immeasurable.

The Brigade's Four Fold were not just words to Dick; they were the cornerstone of his life. He instilled in countless youth the values of being their "My Own Self, At My Very Best, All The Time." Under his mentorship, generations of young leaders emerged, shaped by his wisdom, philosophy, and commitment to leaving things better than he found it.

Beyond his impressive list of accomplishments, Dick's true gift to us was his profound philosophy to seek out adventures and turn those experiences into art. He lived this daily, encouraging all he met to embrace life's challenges and joys with an open heart and a creative spirit.
